Your Eminence - Pastor Emmanuel Mobiyina Oshoffa,

We greet you in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and pray for God's guidance and empowerment in the onerous tasks ahead.

It is regrettably observed that none of our previous two letters of January 05 and that of February 09, 2021 drawing your attention to the anomalies in the representation of US Diocese in the newly constituted Pastor - in -Council had received your attention.

It has also been painfully observed over a period that a number of processes required to be put in place to keep this church on a contemporary pedestal of relevance, recognition and growth spiritually, administratively, legally, financially and developmentally are missing. Under the current crisis management, there remains a growing disaffection, abuses, compromises, and fraternities that continue to disenfranchise the loyalty and faith of long-standing members.

As we cannot all continue to watch helplessly this Lord's given Vessel of Salvation, as it continues to be tossed through tempestuous waves of uncharted Sea, the Executive Council of United States of America Diocese at its Emergency Meeting of Thursday March 04, 2021, consequently resolved by 40 Yea and 1 Abstain of the attendees, to put the following recommendations jointly to your office and the Church's Board of Trustees for urgent consideration and implementation:

1. An effective/appropriate Structure with sound hierarchical set-up, effective span of control, clear definition of roles, clear communication lines and dynamic information system designed by professional minds. It is time for this church to move forward.

- 5. Resolution of the current internal crisis and dichotomy within the **Board of Trustees.**
- 6. A Pastor-in-Council that is anchored on well spelt out individual functions, responsibilities, and authorities.
- 7. An articulate and Standard Manual of Instructions to guide all Ministries, Departments and Operations of the Church.

We regret to advise that until the above concerns for the stabilization, development and growth of the church are addressed, the Diocese of United States of America, from this day March 5, 2021, shall remain independent and be exempted from instruction and directives from any quarter.
